Collection Development

Collection development is the sum of the activities taken to create and maintain library collections which support the current curriculum, encourage the intellectual and emotional growth of students, aid faculty teaching and research, and provide informational resources for the region. These activities are selection and acquisition of current, valid, and relevant material coupled with the weeding from the collections of obsolete, invalid, and irrelevant items. The aim of collection development is to provide the most useful resources available for PSU Library patrons.
